Interviews will run for 10-minutes per child to allow all parents and carers the opportunity to speak with their child's teacher.

The purpose of the interview is to discuss your child's academic and social progress at this stage. Discussion will include how they are progressing in both literacy and numeracy, their attitude to learning, homework, their social well-being, and attendance. It is also an opportunity for parents/carers to raise any concerns.

Please complete and return the attached booking form to your child's teacher by Wednesday 10 September to guarantee a time. Families with more than one child at the school are to list all children on the same form.

Classroom teachers will organise your interviews and a confirmation of your interview time will be sent home. To ensure interviews are kept on schedule, please be on time for your appointment and keep to the appointment length.

Specialist teachers will not be available for these interviews. If you wish to have an interview with one of our specialist teachers, please contact your teacher to arrange a time.
